MESSAGE GUIDANCE: Home Energy Rebates

- The Department of Energy is doing its part to get Home Energy Rebates into the hands of consumers.
- They're providing states with maximum assistance to complete applications and launch programs.
- DOE has received the first applications for program funding from four states.
- Some of these states could begin issuing rebates as soon as Spring 2024.
- These are state-run programs. They will need to apply for funding and put infrastructure in place to administer these rebates.

- Most of the rebates will go to low- and middle-income households, which often aren't able to take full advantage of tax incentives for energy upgrades.
- The Home Energy Rebates are an opportunity for Americans to save money now and later by improving their energy efficiency while helping us fight climate change.
